**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

**DIGESTER COMPLEX - IMPROVEMENTS  
VILLAGE OF ADDISON**

Sealed **Bids** for the “Digester Complex - Improvements” will be received by the Village of Addison, Illinois on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September 2019, up to the hour of 10:00 o’clock A.M. Prevailing Time at the Village’s office located at 1 Friendship Plaza, Addison, IL 60101 and will be publicly opened and read aloud at that time. The project is located at the Village’s North Wastewater Treatment Plant, 711 N. Addison Road; Addison, IL 60101. The project consists of all work for construction of the following:

1. Area A: Site Work: New Waste Gas Burner and Duct Banks
2. Area 6: Secondary Pump Station: New conduit from existing low voltage switch gear
3. Area 8: Digesters and Digester Control Building: New covers, heat exchangers, and pumping systems
4. And all associated architectural, civil, process, mechanical, electrical, instrumentation and control work for a complete and functional wastewater treatment digestion process.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this invitation for bids are expected to be funded in part by a loan from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Illinois EPA). Neither the State of Illinois nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this invitation for bids or any resulting contract. The procurement will be subject to regulations contained in the Procedures for Issuing Loans from the Water Pollution Control Loan Program (35 IAC Part 365), the Davis-Bacon Act (40 USC 276a through 276a-5) as defined by the United States Department of Labor, the Employment of Illinois Workers on Public Works Act (30 ILCS 570) and the “Use of American Iron and Steel” requirements as contained in Section 436 of H.R. 3547, The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. This procurement is also subject to the loan recipient’s policy regarding the increased use of disadvantaged business enterprises. The loan recipient’s policy requires all bidders to undertake specified affirmative efforts at least sixteen (16) days prior to bid opening. The policy is contained in the specifications. Bidders are also required to comply with the President’s Executive Order No. 11246, as amended. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in 41 CFR 60-4.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting for all General Contractors interested in submitting a bid proposal will be held on the 22 day of August at 9:00 o’clock A.M. at the Village of Addison North Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 711 N. Addison Road, Addison, IL 60101. The meeting will start at the administration offices for project introduction and questions followed by a tour of the project site. Note: This meeting is mandatory and failure to be present at this meeting will result in the bid not being accepted.

Copies of Instructions for Bidders, Bid Form, Plans, and Specifications are on file for inspection at the office of the Engineer, Deuchler Engineering Corporation, Inc., 230 S. Woodlawn Avenue, Aurora, IL. Contract Documents can be obtained in digital format (PDF) on CD at the office of BHFX, 30W250 Butterfield Road, Warrenville, IL 60555 (telephone: 630-393-0777) upon payment of a \$150.00 **non-refundable** deposit. Checks for the Contract Documents in digital format shall be made payable to the Engineer. Bidders may also request printed sets of Contract Documents from BHFX. Bidders shall be responsible for all printing and shipping/ mailing costs for all printed sets of Contract Documents. A plan holders list will be maintained by BHFX and will be available for viewing on its website at [www.bhfxplanroom.com](http://www.bhfxplanroom.com).

All **Bids** shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions for Bidders and shall be accompanied by a **Bid** guarantee consisting of a bank cashier's check, bank draft, or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total Bid as provided for under terms of said Instructions for Bidders and Specifications. Complete instructions for filing Bids are included in the Instructions for Bidders.

The Village of Addison reserves the right to reject all **Bids** if it has documented sound business reasons. Unless all bids are rejected, award will be made to the low, responsive, responsible **Bidder** after the bid evaluation has been submitted to the IEPA and written notice of the IEPA approval has been received by the Village of Addison.
